## Admission Requirements:

1. Admission to Lincoln Memorial University
2. Formal application for admission to the program.
3. Acceptance physical examination, including a negative drug screen.
4. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale.
5. Completion of a minimum of 65 semester hours including the completion of a minimum of 8 semester hours of biology and 12 semester hours of chemistry with a minimum grade of a "C-" in each course.
