What are the Clery reportable locations?

To qualify as reportable, a Clery Act crime must have occurred in one of the following locations:

On-campus: Any building or property owned or controlled by the university within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area and used by the university in direct support of, or in a manner related to, the university's educational purpose, including buildings or property the location described herein that is owned by the university but controlled by another person and which is frequently used by students.

Non-campus property: Any non-campus property or building owned or controlled (leased) by the university that is frequently used by students and is not within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution.

Public Property: Any public property located immediately adjacent to, and accessible from campus, including public garages, thoroughfares, sidewalks, streets, lands, parks, that is within the campus, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus
