Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) Part-Time Curriculum Plan

The following is a suggested plan of study for students entering the CSON ASN program as part-time status. Students may enter the ASN program after completing some or all the General Education requirements. This plan should be used in conjunction with the University catalog and in consultation with the nursing advisor. Transfer students should contact a nursing advisor if they have questions regarding transfer credit. General Education courses transferred in must be from an accredited institution and must carry a grade of "C" or better. LMU also requires all first-time freshmen students with less than 15 credits of college credit to complete UACT 100 (1 cr hr).
