


## Accessing Library Resources Off Campus

Finding articles, ebooks and other e-resources that you might need is easy and all that you will need is a device and your LMU username and password.

1. Go to the LMU Library Home Page at <http://library.lmunet.edu/library>
2. From the home page there are several ways to find what you are looking for
  - Use the search feature to look for keywords, authors and titles across our collection
  - Look to the far left at our full text journal collection, book delivery and interlibrary loan options
  - Browse databases
3. In order to see the full text articles off site, you will need to log in using your username and password (**Do NOT use the @lmunet.edu portion!**)
4. Here's the best place to start (far left of home page) if you're looking for a **specific article or volume/issue:**

#1: Click on the "Full Text Journal" option



#2: Type the title of the journal or article into the search bar (be sure to select the tab for the appropriate search)





5. And here's the best place to start if you're looking for resources regarding a **broader subject topic**:

#1: Search for your subject topic



#2: Limit your search results to LMU Libraries and "Full Text"



#3: Click the article title you'd like to view

#4: Enter your username (NO @Imunet.edu) and password



#5: If PDF access is allowed you can download the article in its original format. If not you can still read the HTML version. **Note:** not all databases or other journal access points have the same format and things may look different as you search
