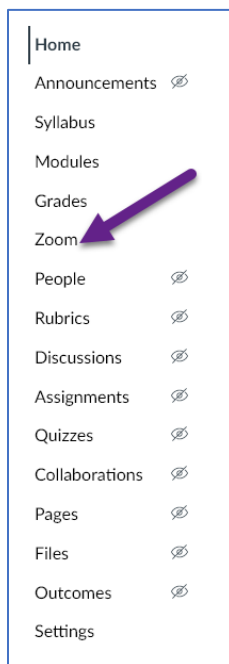


## Create a Bookable Zoom Meeting Schedule for Students within Canvas

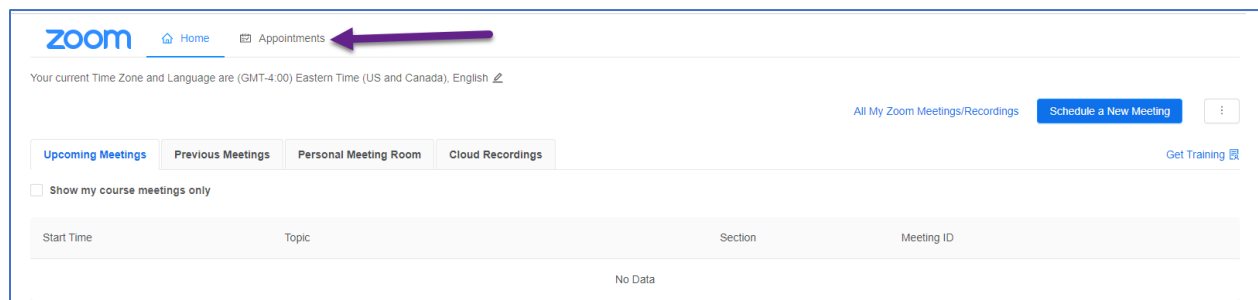
With the Zoom integration in Canvas you can create schedules with dates and time slots on a module so that students can book to meet with you over Zoom. This is very useful for office hours/1:1 meetings.

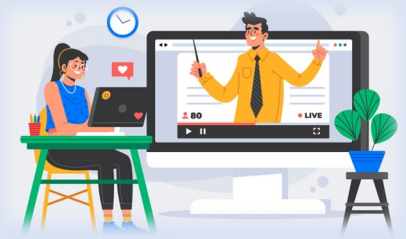
To create a booking Zoom meeting schedule for your students within a Canvas module, complete the following steps:

1. Select "Zoom" from the Course Navigation menu.

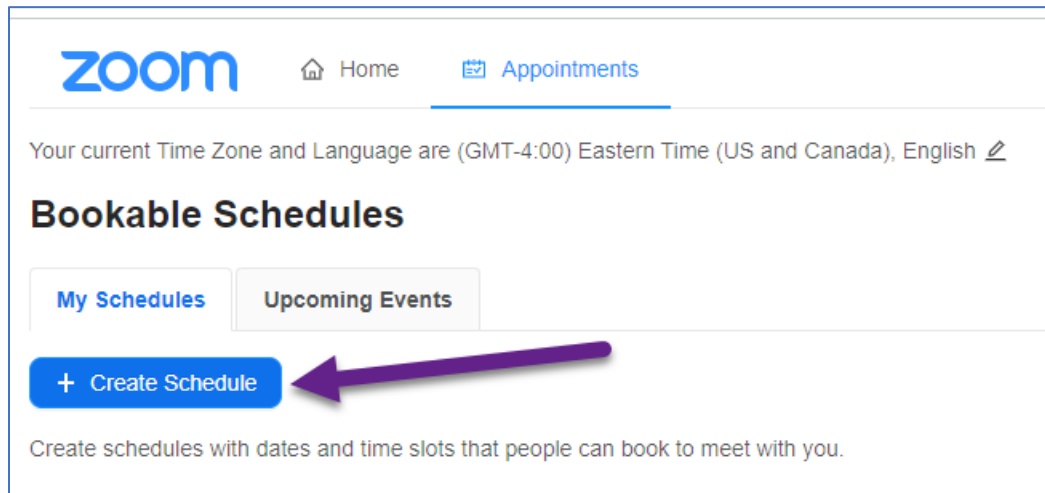


2. Select the "Appointments" tab at the top of the page.

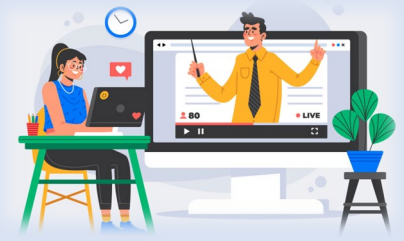




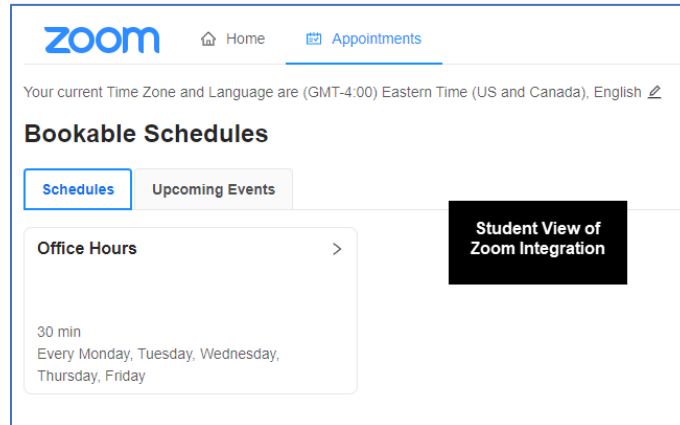
3. Under the "My Schedules tab" select "Create Schedule."



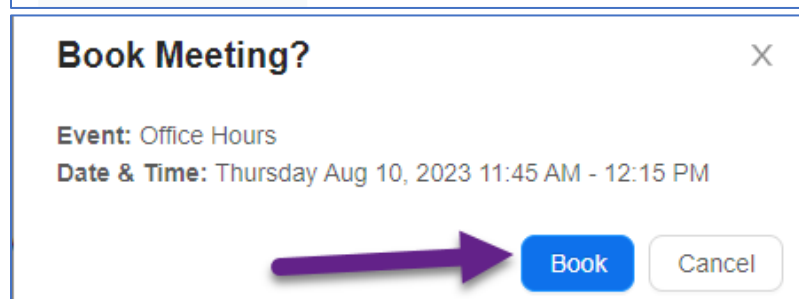
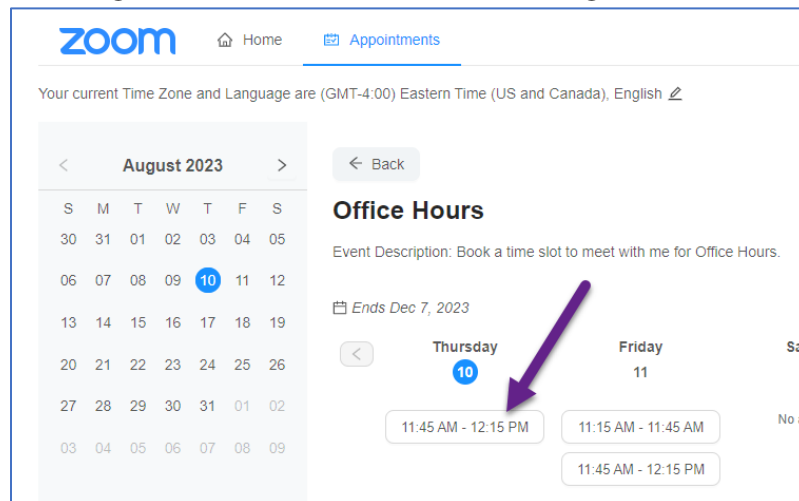
4. Fill out all of the information in the New Bookable Schedule window:
- Select the days and times are available to be booked.
  - Select the duration of bookable slots.
  - Enter a name in the Event Name field (e.g. "Office hours").
  - Optional: Enter an event description in the Event Description field.
  - Select "Create."



5. Students can now book a slot for a meeting by doing the following:
  - a. navigating to the Zoom tab of the module, selecting "Appointments," and selecting the available schedule.



- b. selecting an available time slot and selecting "Book."





- The booked meeting will then appear on the instructor's "Appointments" tab under "Upcoming Events."
