- Offer five faculty-led workshops.

Summer Training

Mentors will gather via
Zoom for 3 group
trainings on best
practices.

Host One 2024-2025 Workshop

Host a campus-wide session on a mentor topic-of-choice.

Connect with Mentees

Interested mentees will be paired with mentors based on survey responses.



Mentor Benefits

Stipend

Receive a \$1,000 stipend for their work

Recognition

Recognized as a Certified Mentor for their leadership by ORGSP

Professional Development

Receive a package of materials for professional development

April 2024:

June, July, August 2024: Mentor Training

- Three Zoom meetings
- Mailed hard copies of professional development guides
- Meetings will be group discussions of provided readings



September 2024: Mentee Recruitment Begins

- MyLMU announcement of mentorship opportunity
- Online mentee survey released at lmunet.edu/orgsp
- ORGSP will facilitate pairings



October 2024 – April 2025

- Mentors will select a month to host a presentation of their choice, themed around a topic of mentoring advice.
- ORGSP will facilitate presentations.
- Mentors will be open to contact from potential mentees.





How will mentorship work?

- Once paired, potential mentors and mentees will schedule at least one meeting together
- If interest is established, the pair will...
 - Create a meeting schedule based on mentee interest
 - Establish clear, shared expectations for relationships, including time commitments
 - Set clear communication preferences and expectations



Wait! Is this more than I can handle?

LMU faculty – both mentors and mentees – are busy people! ORGSP will counsel on healthy time commitment agreements for both mentors and mentees.

Goal: a mutually beneficial partnership that is respectful of both parties' time.
