

Advance to Master's Program (AMP) Application

The Advance to Master's Program is an accelerated learning opportunity offered through Lincoln Memorial University's School of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences, and the School of Business. Exceptional students will be allowed the opportunity to complete a maximum 6 credit hours of graduate level coursework (LMU's MPA, MSCJ, MSP, MBA) prior to the completion of their undergraduate studies. To be eligible for LMU's AMP Program, students must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Senior status (completed a minimum of 92 credit hours)
- 2) Have a GPA of 3.5 in both their major and overall GPA
- 3) Receive approval from the students' Academic Advisor, the Department Chair, the Graduate Program Admissions Council, and the School's Dean.
- 4) Meet all behavior and attitude elements of the student conduct code as stated in the Railspitter Community Standards Guide
- 5) Other requirements imposed by each School

Graduate credit hours completed while in the AMP program will apply only to undergraduate upper division elective requirements. The graduate credit hours will also count as graduate credits in the related LMU graduate degree programs.
