## Four-year Plan Pre-Law BBA (3+3)

The following is a **suggested** four-year plan of study for freshmen entering LMU during the 2024-2025 academic year. This plan should be used in conjunction with the University catalog and in consultation with a faculty advisor in the School of Business and Duncan School of Law (DSOL). Students must be admitted to the LMU Duncan School of Law to complete this program. Upon completion of their first year of Law School students seeking the PLAW.BBA will be awarded the PLAW.BBA degree and continue in DSOL's J.D. program. Transfer students should consult their advisors regarding transfer credit. Courses listed on the four-year plan may be taken out of sequence, based on availability and course placement. "Senior Year/First Year Duncan School of Law" courses are contingent on current DSOL admission requirements and must total at least 24 credit hours. This plan meets LMU's general education (Liberal Arts Common Core) requirements, major requirements and 300/400 level course requirements. **NOTE: Please refer to the legend at the bottom of the page for an explanation of superscripts. LMU also requires all first-time freshmen students with less than 15 credits of college credit to complete UACT 100.**
